

Will collection effort milestone reported

JOLIET—Will County Circuit Clerk, Pam McGuire reported a collection effort milestone.

“Since its inception in May of 2007, the collection program initiated by the Will County circuit clerk’s office, in partnership with Jim Glasgow, Will County state’s attorney, and Larry Walsh, Will County executive, has diligently pursued the collection of past due fines and fees,” McGuire said.

“This program, that generates additional revenues for the county, state and municipalities throughout Will County, has now passed \$2 million in collections.”

“The revenue we’ve been able to bring in is remarkable,” said Walsh.

The state’s attorney and the circuit clerk entered into a contract with Harris and Harris Ltd. and the law offices of Arnold Scott Harris to collect the past-due court fines and fees.

McGuire reports that since the office went live with the collection effort, Will County has received \$777,131 in revenue.

Other municipalities also have benefited, among them: Bolingbrook, \$85,680; Joliet, \$222,332; Romeoville, \$62,514; Plainfield, \$48,520; and Frankfort, \$31,465.
